

FIRST CHRISTIAN CHURCH DENTON BOARD MEETING MINUTES APRIL 17, 2011

Meeting was called to Order with prayer by J.HOLT at 4:07 p.m.

Minutes of 03/17/11 were read and APPROVED AS CORRECTED.

Treasury report was reviewed by S.HOLT. She explained that the two areas behind in funding are Section Leaders and Youth Choir Director. Health insurance costs for Dixie Smalley and Mark Graham are off by 10% due to increase. Nursery Attendant costs are more because there are now two attendants. Nursery will be provided for Maudy Thursday services. Stewardship and Church Growth categories are higher than expected because they include the one time annual fee to the software developer. Gas heating costs were unusually high. Gas and electric usage to be reviewed by formula by H.BURKE and J.BURTON before renewing the Home School contract in June. Giving increased in April due to one time gifts.

Reports from Committees:

Worship: No report. Russell Robertson did the palms and organized the youth for Palm Sunday.

Education: No report.

Membership: L.MORROW announced there will be a Fellowship Dinner May 22 for the visiting minister. Proceeds to go to the new church in Prosper.

Stewardship: R.WATSON reported that the Financial Report in the newsletter has produced results.

Church Growth: No report. Duncans are working on bracelets, the ad for the *Denton Record Chronicle* with much energy going to the website. Bart Yoder will be uploading videos to the website.

Property: R.WATSON has inventoried the contents of the safe deposit box and will recommend closing it. It contained no historical documents. J.TOMKINS is working on the landscaping between the Fellowship Hall and the back parking lot, to be done by the end of May.

Disciples Women: L.MORROW reported that the Garage Sale is scheduled for Saturday, June 4 with proceeds to be split between DW and DM group and either the General Fund or the Roof Fund.

Disciples Men: R.WATSON announced that the group is providing two Easter lilies in remembrance of our founders. The group will also be providing flowers for Mothers' Day and helping with Garage Sale.

Reverands Steve Shewmate, Oran and Charlotte Nabors will be assisting in this service. BURTON will attend General Assembly July 7-13 in Nashville, TN; participate in the Iowa bike ride; and attend the Pastoral meeting at Ghost Ranch, NM in August.

NEXT MEETING will be June 26 when we will need to review/renew Cassie Sexton's contract and conduct any other business. Board meetings will be scheduled every other month on the third Sunday alternating with the Cabinet meetings.
